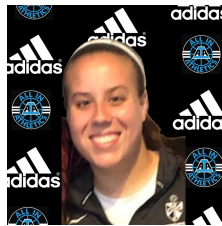

2024 REGIONAL AND NATIONAL TEAM CIRCUITS

ALL IN ATHLETICS IS A CERTIFIED ADIDAS 3SGB PROGRAM FOR BOYS & 3SSB PROGRAM FOR GIRLS

ALL IN is 1 of very few Certified adidas grassroots programs in the country for boys AND girls. ALL IN is 1 of 45 boys 3SGB programs and 1 of 35 girls 3SSB programs across the country that has been invited to play on their respective adidas circuits this season.

The Boys 3SGB is a three-stop circuit and the Girls 3SSB/3SGB is a three-stop circuit for adidas sponsored teams to gain exposure in front of college coaches, media outlets and their peers. Teams face high level national competition, including top 100 players & McDonald's All-Americans. This level of competition prepares players for the challenges and situations they will ultimately face in college, an opportunity that very few programs in the state are able to offer.

The top team at each age group (15U, 16U, 17U) will compete on the adidas 3SGB and they will have the opportunity to play against the 3SSB teams during July's Live Period (where Division I college coaches will be in attendance)..

ALL IN Elite girls high school teams will play on the adidas 3SSB & adidas 3SGB.

The top team at each age group (15U, 16U, 17U) will compete on the adidas 3SSB circuit.



NY2LA BASKETBALL ASSOCIATION

ALL IN Regional boys high school teams will play in the NY2LA Basketball Association. At least one team at each age group (15U, 16U, 17U) will compete in the NY2LA Basketball Association. The NY2LA Basketball Association is a high caliber grassroots league that features some of the most talented programs and prospects in the country each year. With quality exposure opportunities at a premium during critical viewing periods each year, the NY2LA Basketball Association will play host to 15U-17U teams and it will be held on select "live" period evaluation weekends during the spring and summer.



PREP HOOPS CIRCUIT

ALL IN Regional boys high school teams will play on the Prep Hoops Circuit. At least one team at each age group (15U, 16U, 17U) will compete on the Prep Hoops Circuit. The Prep Hoops Circuit is the largest independent league in grassroots basketball. Prep Hoops acts as the subject matter expert for coverage and content in 35 states across the country. Teams that participate in Prep Hoops events will be covered on the Prep Hoops media page.



U.S. JUNIOR NATIONALS (USJN)

USJN is one of the longest running organizations in girls' basketball, and has been running tournaments across the country since 1986, as the first privately owned company outside of AAU to offer girls basketball tournaments. USJN runs a number of major exposure events in the Midwest that ALL IN 12U-17U Elite & Select level teams will participate in over the course of the spring and summer.



GENERATION NEXT BASKETBALL ASSOCIATION (GNBA)

ALL IN National 6th-8th grade boys teams will play in NY2LA's Generation Next Basketball Association (GNBA). The GNBA provides some of the premier middle school competition in the country with multiple opportunities for prospects to deliver, develop, and improve while also providing them quality early introduction into the exposure process both regionally and nationally.
