



# 2026 REGIONAL AND NATIONAL TEAM CIRCUITS

## ALL IN ATHLETICS IS A CERTIFIED NEW BALANCE P32 PROGRAM FOR BOYS AND GIRLS.

ALL IN is proud to be one of a select group of Certified New Balance grassroots programs in the country for both boys and girls. Our top teams compete on the New Balance P32/E32 (boys) & New Balance Lady P32/E32 (girls). The P32/E32 and Lady P32/E32 circuits feature multiple stops throughout the spring and summer, including NCAA Live Period events, providing athletes with consistent exposure in front of college coaches, media outlets, and elite competition from across the country.

ALL IN teams will face top-tier national competition, including high-major prospects and nationally ranked players. This environment challenges athletes, accelerates development, and prepares them for the demands they will face at the collegiate level—an opportunity very few programs in the region are able to offer.

Our top teams at each age group (15U, 16U, 17U) will compete on the New Balance P32 and Lady P32 circuits, while additional boys and girls teams will compete on E32, ensuring a clear pathway for growth, exposure, and advancement within the ALL IN program.



## NY2LA BASKETBALL ASSOCIATION

ALL IN National boys high school teams will play in the NY2LA Basketball Association. At least one team at each age group (15U, 16U, 17U) will compete in the NY2LA Basketball Association. The NY2LA Basketball Association is a high caliber grassroots league that features some of the most talented programs and prospects in the country each year. With quality exposure opportunities at a premium during critical viewing periods each year, the NY2LA Basketball Association will play host to 15U-17U teams and it will be held on select "live" period evaluation weekends during the spring and summer.



## PREP HOOPS CIRCUIT

ALL IN Regional boys high school teams will play on the Prep Hoops Circuit. At least one team at each age group (15U, 16U, 17U) will compete on the Prep Hoops Circuit. The Prep Hoops Circuit is the largest independent league in grassroots basketball. Prep Hoops acts as the subject matter expert for coverage and content in 35 states across the country. Teams that participate in Prep Hoops events will be covered on the Prep Hoops media page.



## BLUE STAR LEAGUE

ALL IN National girls high school teams will play in the Blue Star League. At least two high school girls teams will compete in this circuit. The Blue Star Basketball League provides elite competition and exposure. Organized under the Blue Star Media umbrella, the league features top club programs nationwide, offering high-level competition and national scouting coverage.



## JR. P32 Boys

ALL IN National 6th-8th grade boys teams will play on the New Balance Jr. P32 Circuit. The New Balance Jr. P32 circuit provides some of the premier middle school competition in the country with multiple opportunities for prospects to deliver, develop, and improve while also providing them quality early introduction into the exposure process both regionally and nationally. Teams will also play in other national events, including but not limited to GNBA, Prep Hoops Next & Jr. Hoops Elite.



## COMMITMENT TO PLAYER EXPOSURE
